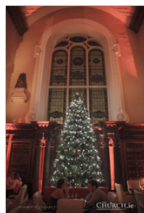


MATT TALBOT NOVENA

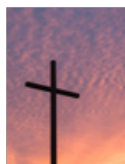
REMEMBRANCE TREE CARDS
